



#### LETTER FROM FR. DAN

Dear Friend,

This Sunday at the 11am Mass we will welcome our brothers and sisters who are preparing for the sacraments of initiation at Easter -Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion. We celebrate this Rite of Welcome quite



appropriately on a weekend when our readings point us not only to the joy of the Lord in our lives, but also, more subtly, to the challenge of looking more deeply into our lives and our behavior. In other words, reorienting the eyes of our heart to the wider lens on life offered by Jesus Christ opens us to beauty, but can be an uncomfortable stretch.

The challenge of seeing deeply and responding more fully is captured in John the Baptist's words to the religious leaders: "There is one among you," he tells them, "whom you do not recognize, the one who is coming after me..." The reading ends right before John sees Jesus coming toward him. He cries out: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world...", a phrase that a priest like me can smoothly speak at Mass and have difficulty translating into the liturgy of life, as a member of a perfectly imperfect community.

"Advent's adventure is to move from seeing to beholding," writes theologian Richard Gula (italics mine). With this Sunday's text, we're not quite there yet. What is blinding us from seeing the Lamb of God and acting accordingly? Have we "settled in" to the way it's always been? Like our newcomers each one of us is called into a deeper experience of life and faith as part of a beloved community planted in a world that can be hostile. Each Eucharist is the repeated sacrament of our initiation. Will our newcomers find in us living signs of humility and joy?


You can help make our outdoor Mass on Christmas Eve a success!

# BECOMING A LAUDATO SI' PARISH

# LAUDATO DEUM: 4. CLIMATE CONFERENCES: PROGRESS AND FAILURES

The juxtaposition of our Advent scriptures and Pope Francis' assessment of the global climate conferences that have taken place since 1992 is dramatic. Isaiah tells us to take comfort, even to exult, in the coming day of the Lord when justice and peace shall reign on Zion. The nations shall come together in good will and harmony. In his brief review of the history of the Conference of Parties (COP), the pope sees progress but also failure.

A 1992 conference in Rio de Janeiro established the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, which took effect in 1994. The Conference of Parties in Dubai, which concluded this past week, is the 28th such meeting. *Laudato Si'* was published in 2015 with an eye to influencing COP21 in Paris, which "can be considered as a new beginning, given the failure to meet the goals previously set." The problem is that "there are no provisions for sanctions in the case of unfulfilled commitments, nor effective instruments to ensure their fulfillment."

In keeping with the spirit of Advent, let us hope that the peace of Isaiah and the integral ecology of Pope Francis move a little closer to realization in the coming year.

Before you head out into the holiday frenzy, talk to your children about some ground rules: Stay together and communicate about where you are headed if you change directions or plans. Consider the "two big steps" rule, which tells your child not to be more than two steps away from you at all times. That way, you can easily keep eyes on each other.
