



LETTER FROM FR. DAN

Dear Friend,

In a recent conversation about our lives as friars, I was struck by the comment of one participant who observed that Acts of the Apostles is still being written. He was referring, of course, to the New Testament



text that tells the story of the early church and the experience of Paul. It is considered to be the second volume of Luke's Gospel, and it's really the story of the Holy Spirit.


The great scholar of the Hebrew scriptures, Ellen Davis, would certainly agree. In her advice to preachers, she points out that while the biblical story as recounted in the scriptures is complete, it is not yet finished; that is, it is still being retold and enacted and commented upon, as it must be, as long as the church awaits the consummation of history (p. 246, Preaching the Luminous Word).

The readings for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time this weekend will highlight this fact with their emphasis on the themes of prophecy and authority. The voice of Jesus, as the fulfillment of prophecy and as the one who "speaks with authority" is the basis for the on-going call, conversion, and shaping of the Church, which is our story.

Our parish is so filled with stories of faith, testimonies to the work of the Spirit, the presence of Jesus, and the creative power of the Father. It has been one of the great rewards to me as Pastor to hear these stories. The questions that emerge for me are: Amidst the anxieties Paul writes about, How do I keep attuned to the voice of the Lord? In line with the Psalmist, How do I soften my heart to stay open to that voice of love and life? These questions stay with me.

BECOMING A LAUDATO SI' PARISH

THE BISHOPS ON PAST AND PRESENT RACISM IN THE USA

"During our time [in Montgomery, Alabama] we recognized the Quad-Centennial of the forced migration of African peoples from Angola to Jamestown, VA, in 1619 as an event which marked the beginning of a highly tragic period in our nation's history... As we visited the Legacy Museum of the Equal Justice Initiative, we were made more fully aware of the indignities of slavery and the continuation of indignities after emancipation through the enactment and enforcement of prejudicial laws and policies which upheld racial prejudice, white supremacy, and inequity." Reaffirmation of our Commitment to End Racism, signed by ten ecumenical leaders including Rev. Dr. Walter F. Kedjierski, Executive Director of the Secretariat for Ecumenical and Inter-Religious Affairs, U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.

"Today, I again address the grave sin of racism, which continues to plague our society and even our own Church...As my brother bishops noted in their 2018 Pastoral Letter on racism, *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love:* 'Many of our institutions still harbor, and too many of our laws still sanction, practices that deny justice and equal access to certain groups of people." Most Reverend Nelson J. Pérez, D.D., Archbishop of Philadelphia, *A Pastoral Letter on Racial Healing: "We Are One Body,"* June 11, 2023.
